

Fret 2: Place Finger 1 on the C string and use Finger 2 to fret the A string.

Fret 3: Position Finger 3 on the E string.







Fret 3: Position Finger 3 on the bottom string (A string).






Fret 2: Place Fingers 1, 2 and 3 on the G, C and E strings.



Strumming 2

We are going to briefly look at five strumming patterns and then use some of the patterns to play a couple of songs.

Counting

To get really steady strumming we need to be able to count the beats consistently –



I Wish I Was a Mole in the Ground - Trad.

Verse 1: I [G] wish I was a [D] mole in the [G] ground
Yes, I [C] wish I was a mole in the [G] ground
If I'm a [C] mole in the [G] ground I'd root that mountain [C] down
And I [G] wish I was a [D] mole in the [G] ground

Verse 2: Oh, I [G] wish I was a [D] lizard in the [G] spring
Yes, I [C] wish I was a lizard in the [G] spring
If I'm a [C] lizard in the [G] spring I'd hear my darlin' [C] sing
And I [G] wish I was a [D] lizard in the [G] spring

Verse 3: Oh, [G] Tippy wants a [D] nine dollar [G] shawl
Yes, [C] Tippy wants a nine dollar [G] shawl
When [C] I come o'er the [G] hill with a forty dollar [C] bill
[G] Baby, where you [D] been so [G] long?

Verse 4: Oh [G] Tippy, let your [D] hair roll [G] down
[C] Tippy, let your hair roll [G] down
Let your [C] hair roll [G] down and your bangs curl [C] round
Oh [G] Tippy, let your [D] hair roll [G] down

Verse 5: I [G] been in the [D] bend so [G] long
Yes, [C] I been in the bend so [G] long
I [C] been in the [G] bend with the rough and rowdy [C] men
[G] Baby, where you [D] been so [G] long?

Verse 6: Oh, [G] I don't like a [D] railroad [G] man
No, [C] I don't like a railroad [G] man
If I'm a [C] railroad [G] man then I'll kill you when I [C] can
[G] Drink up your [D] blood like [G] wine

Verse 7: I [G] wish I was a [D] turtle in the [G] pond
I [C] wish I was a turtle in the [G] pond
If I's a [C] turtle in the [G] pond I would stay there all day [C] long
I [G] wish I was a [D] turtle in the [G] pond

Verse 8: I [G] wish I was a [D] mole in the [G] ground
Yes, I [C] wish I was a mole in the [G] ground

Intro: c g x 8©

Verse 1: [C] We'll do it all [F] everything

[G] on our own c g x8©

[C] We don't need [F] anything

[G] or anyone c g x6©

Chorus: (Tacet) If I lay [C] here if I just [G] lay here

Would you lie [F] with me and just forget the world c g x8©

Verse 2: [C] I don't quite know [F] how to say

[G] how I feel c g x8©

[C] Those three words [F] are said too much

[G] They're not enough c g x6©

Chorus: (Tacet) If I lay [C] here if I just [G] lay here

Would you lie [F] with me and just forget the world [C] 234 1234 1234

[C] Forget what we're told before we [G] get too old Show me a [F] garden that's bursting into life c g x8©

Verse 3: [C] Let's waste time [F] chasing cars

[G] Around our heads c g x8©

[C] I need your grace [F] to remind me

[G] To find my own c g x6©

Chorus: (Tacet) If I lay [C] here if I just [G] lay here

Outro: If I lay [C] here if I just [G] lay here

Would you lie [F] with me and just forget the world c g x8© [Cp]

Notes:

1. Intro, Verse and Outro are all played finger picking the C and G strings only. I use my thumb and first finger.

- 2. © = cycle i.e. one pluck of G and C string so 8© = play G and C string 8 times each
- 3. Chorus is strummed with a moderately fast down strum only. The last **[C]** of each chorus is not strummed but reverts to the fingerpicking
- 4. **[Cp]** Pinch G and C strings to finish
