Notes:

- 1. Intro, Verse and Outro are all played finger picking the C and G strings only. I use my thumb and first finger.
- 2. © = cycle i.e. one pluck of G and C string so 8© = play G and C string 8 times each
- 3. Chorus is strummed with a moderately fast down strum only. The last **[C]** of each chorus is not strummed but reverts to the fingerpicking
- 4. **[Cp]** Pinch G and C strings to finish
