

By putting fingers in shape 1 below then moving tp shape 2 by lifting finger you can play first two lines. Also keeping fingers loosely in these positions can play next line and a half.





Starting position – a Cm chord shape








You will recognise this as your ukulele fret board with a bar across the third fret and some suggested notes on the sixth and fifth frets.

Solomon Grundy

To play the riff for Solomon Grundy you play – 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8

However there are lots of other riffs and keys you can play –

Changing key

If you wanted to play the same riff in for instance D rather than C just move everything up two frets. If you wanted to play in Bb (and wouldn't that be impressive) move it all down two frets – and yes you don't need a bar as the nut becomes the bar.

Playing different riffs

Start getting imaginative and work out your own riffs using those eight notes. Try, 5 5 1 2 3 4 5 6
